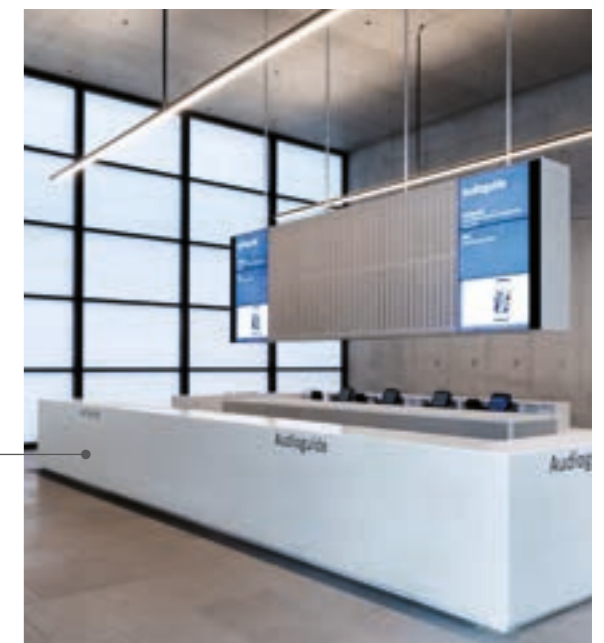

- S828 HIMACS-UV+ (Alpine White) is the new formulation, specifically optimised for outdoor use with even greater UV resistance. This is especially important for facades exposed to very intense sunlight.
- All HIMACS colours with the sun symbol can be safely used outdoors. The colours can be found on pages 52 to 67.



The stars shine bright outside

This wonderful facade of a sport hall complex is an impressive 2,100 m². HIMACS was chosen because of its aesthetic – and its certified fire resistance. HIMACS successfully underwent numerous fire resistance tests, and has received the NRO (Non Spreading Fire) certificate from the Polish Fire Test Facility (ITB), making it one of only a very few solid surface materials to be approved in Poland for use in outdoor facades.



Modern CNC milling technology allowed all facade elements to be individually designed; the expansion joint – a required part of the facade – is transformed into a cool design element.

The geometric honeycomb pattern gives the building a sense of transparency and stability all at once.
